Tuition Fees

The tuition fees are payable in advance and cover four terms (one year). The fees cover all tuition and text books.

Stationery, public examination fees (Years 11, 12, 13), college uniform, field trips, camp fees, transport to and from school, music equipment hire, music lessons or sport costs are not included in this fee and need to be paid separately.

Administration

Administration Fee of \$1,000. If paying from an overseas bank, \$25 is to be added for the international bank transfer fee. If paying by credit card, there will be a 1.89% merchant charge added to the total of the payment.

Homestay

Homestay costs \$280 per week, which amounts to \$13,440 for 48 weeks. In addition, there is a placement fee of \$260 applicable for the initial homestay placement and for any future changes if requested by student or agent. Homestays provide three meals daily and laundry but do **not** cover costs relating to phone cards, internet use or connection, personal toiletries or transport to and from school. If the student departs in less than 48 weeks the balance is refunded.

*School Related Activities

This is for other school related incidentals for the school year, including NCEA exam fees, field trips, sport and music costs and stationery. Any surplus remaining in the activity fund at the end of the student's school year can be refunded by request, subject to all outstanding fees and payments being made. School Related Activities fee can be invoiced separately by request, and must be paid before the students arrives at the College.

**Medical & Travel Insurance

The school can arrange Southern Cross Medical and Travel Insurance if requested. Own insurance may be arranged through a reputable Insurance Company, and evidence must be shown that full medical and travel insurance is held for the student. Medical and Travel Insurance is compulsory for the duration of students stay in NZ and must be shown when obtaining an Immigration NZ Student Visa.

Support Person

All students must have an Auckland resident support person who speaks both the student's native language and English. This can be arranged by the school for an annual fee of \$3,000.

Uniform

New uniform costs are approximately \$600 to \$800 depending on choice of items and year level. This is to be organised by the student's support person. Second hand uniform may be purchased at school for approximately \$300.



Homestay Fees Policy

- Two weeks' notice or \$560 must be given to the homestay when the student is leaving.
- Homestay placement/administration fee of \$260 is paid every year. A homestay placement fee of \$260 will also apply to each new or change of homestay for both long and short-term students.
- Homestay families are paid \$280 per week during term break holidays, even if the student has their own holiday arrangements. If a student is absent from their homestay during term time for longer than two weeks (subject to the Principal's approval) a payment of \$560 must be made for the first two weeks, then \$50 per week after that (to a maximum of \$250).
- If a student leaves the homestay at the end of the school year but wants to come back ('retain') to the same homestay the following year, two weeks notice must be given and \$50 per week Homestay Retainer Fee (to a maximum of \$250) must be paid.
